- Collaborate with audit team members to identify and assess risks, and to develop audit plans
- Develop and maintain documentation of data analysis and audit procedures

Your profile:

- Currently pursuing a degree in a quantitative field such as mathematics, statistics, computer science, or economics
- Strong analytical and problem-solving skills, with attention to detail and ability to work accurately
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office, particularly Excel, and ability to learn new software and tools quickly
- Familiarity with data analysis and visualization tools such as Tableau, Power BI, or Python
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills, with ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment and meet deadlines
- Familiarity with auditing concepts and principles is a plus
- Fluency in English (additional languages are a plus)
